What's SATREPS Project?

Since 2017, the joint team of Fukushima University, University of Tsukuba, Fukushima Medical University and 12 Ukrainian institutes is executing the project. The goals of the project is to implement new technologies of field monitoring, laboratory studies and modeling for the assessment of the main fluxes of Cs-137 and Sr-90 in the area surrounding Chernobyl Exclusion Zone (ChEZ). The project also aims to develop the recommendations for SAUEZM to improve ChEZ management utilizing the experience in Fukushima .
